ABSTRACT

The objective of research was to determine the Evaluation of the Sanitation and Clean Water Development Program in Ambara Village, Dungaliyo District. The research method uses a qualitative type. The results showed the implementation of the sanitation and clean water development program in Ambara Village. Dungaliyo District, Gorontalo Regency was not optimal. This is can be seen from the four indicators tested where the context indicator shows the community's unpreparedness to implementing the program, where community participation in paying a monthly contribution of IDR 5,000 is very low. The input indicators showed the condition of the facilities and infrastructure is inadequate thus they have not been able to reach all hamlets and the condition of the facilities or facilities such as storage tanks and pumping machines are in poor condition. The process indicator shows that the implementation of the sanitation and clean water program has been carried out by the activity executor, namely the Pansimas together with the Village Government through socialization and counseling activities. The product indicator shows that the access of the Ambara village community has not been fulfilled to be served by improving drinking water and sanitation services and facilities as well as increasing the values and behavior of a clean and healthy life.
